STATE AND LOCAL MINIMUM WAGE INCREASES

The Statewide minimum wage increased to \$13.00 for employers with 25 or fewer employees and \$14.00 for employers with 26 or more employees on January 1, 2021.. In addition, local jurisdictions, set higher rates.
